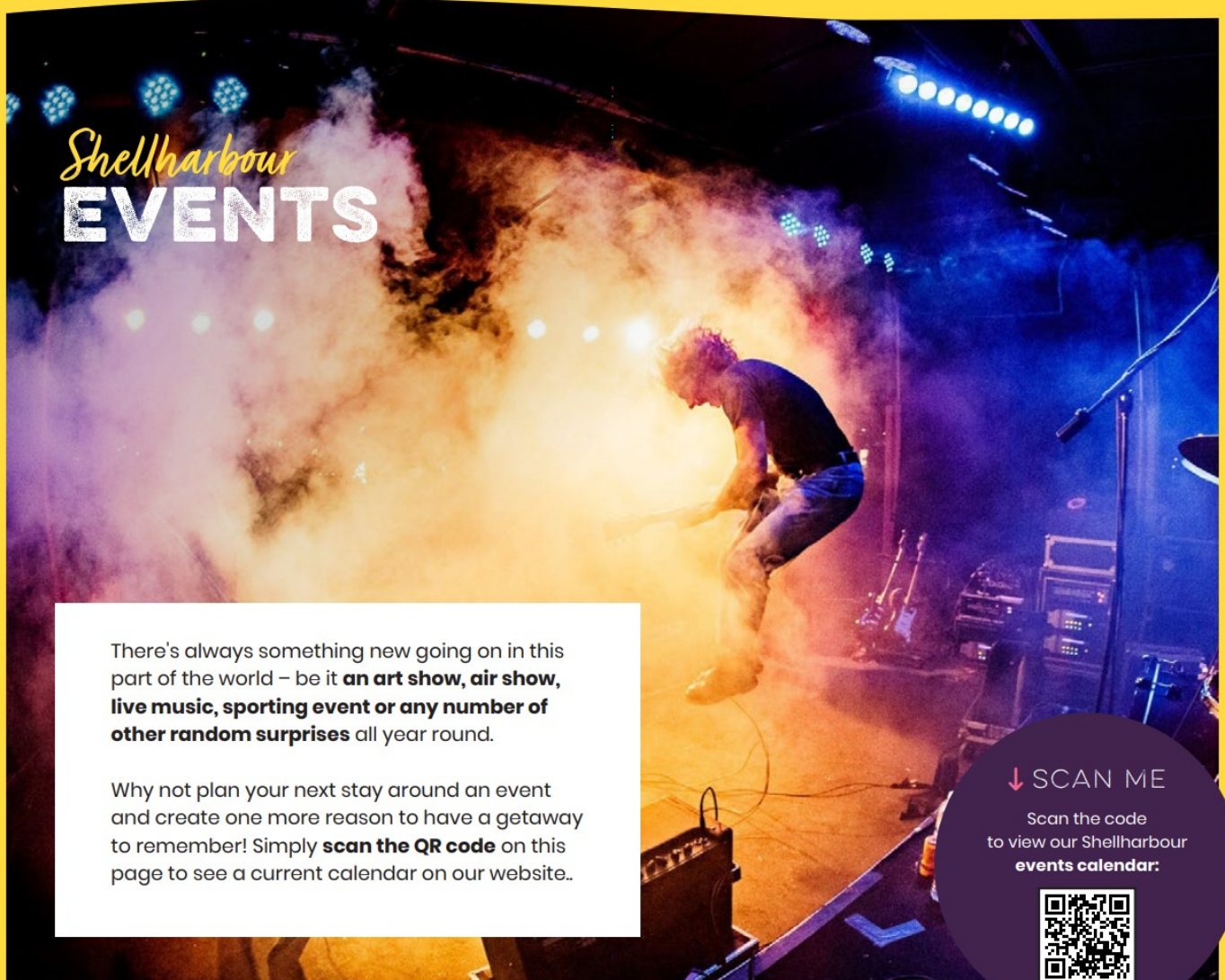

Towns + VILLAGES



Our region is the sum of many parts, interlocking pieces that combine to provide **a patchwork quilt of experiences from the ocean to the escarpment.** Here's a quick introduction...

Centre to it all, **Shellharbour City Centre** is the services and shopping hub – located in the geographical heart of the region. It's here that you'll find all the infrastructure of a thriving city, including the Illawarra's premier shopping centre, cinemas, hospitals and more.

Hungry? The city centre has you covered, with a range of international cuisines on offer in The Avenue dining precinct and beyond. Or explore the modern City Library and Museum alongside the community-friendly Civic Centre.

For the original namesake coastal vibe, head to **Shellharbour Village** – with a browse-friendly mix of retail and dining based around Addison Street as it rolls down to the sparkling ocean. History is front and centre here, with the shell-filled boat harbour giving this region its name.

The art-deco era Ocean Beach Hotel overlooks it all, while fish and chips on the beach is a popular choice. Be sure to download or pick up a Village Heritage Trail brochure and follow the plaques through the streets. Little Park at the harbour is a popular playground for kids, while the harbour is the perfect spot to drop a line or launch your boat from the nearby ramp.

If boats are your thing, bookending our heritage is the brand-new addition to Shellharbour's oceanfront experience – **Shellharbour Marina**. Officially opened in 2021, this engineering masterpiece features state-of-the-art marina berths, a new town centre and alfresco all-day dining options including the prominent Waterfront Tavern. Plus, with more than 2.5km of new boardwalks and promenades encircling this exciting new space, Shell Cove is a great place for walking, jogging or letting the kids take a dip in the wading beach.



Wrapping around this brand-new hive of activity, the scenic **Bass Point and Killalea Regional Park** provide a rugged and ready coastline popular with divers and surfers – flanked by a pristine headland stretch that’s famous for many a car advert!

But the ocean isn’t the only place to enjoy the waterfront. Just a mile inland, **Lake Illawarra** is a large recreation hub – it’s shallow, calm waters making it ideal for boating, fishing or stand-up paddle boarding. Drop a line off the many jetties or make use of the boat ramps, extensive bike paths, playgrounds and BBQ-equipped picnic areas dotted along the foreshore. Reddall Reserve (where the lake meets the sea) is a popular spot for playing and paddling, as well as the start of the sculpture arts trail.

Inland further, Shellharbour Airport (with direct flights to Brisbane and Melbourne) sits alongside **Albion Park & Surrounds** – with plenty of aviation-based activities to enjoy, including the HARS Aviation Museum’s many up-close experiences and a range of rare and iconic aircraft such as a Qantas 747. Want to go higher? You’ll be guaranteed the best view of the region with a flying lesson or skydiving out a plane from 15,000 feet!

If you prefer views without leaving the ground, head towards the towering Illawarra Escarpment, home to **Macquarie Pass & Surrounds**. Out here, rolling dairy farms and old logging remnants give way to ancient rainforest as it clings to the foothills and cliffs. Waterfalls tumble into hidden pools while unique flora and fauna make themselves at home. It’s the ultimate natural playground – an ideal backdrop to this exciting and varied region.

🏠 TOWN TALES

- 📖 The Aboriginal name for Shellharbour has been recorded as both **Yerrowah** (meeting place) and **Wonwin** (place where there were big fish).
- 📖 **Shellharbour Village** was originally known as Peterborough.
- 📖 **Albion Park** was originally called Terry Meadows.
- 📖 **Lake Illawarra** has an average depth of just 2.1 m.
- 📖 The Shellharbour coastline was the site of **9 shipwrecks**, between 1851 and 1943.



Discover our **HISTORY**



With a past that stretches back thousands of years, the story of Shellharbour has been told and retold many times over...

To fully grasp the history of this region, the clock needs to go back an astonishing **17,000 years** – which is when earliest traces of Indigenous occupation of Bass Point have been found. This is one of the oldest sites along the entire eastern coast of Australia, although due to lower ocean levels back then, it wasn't even on the coast – it was 14km inland!

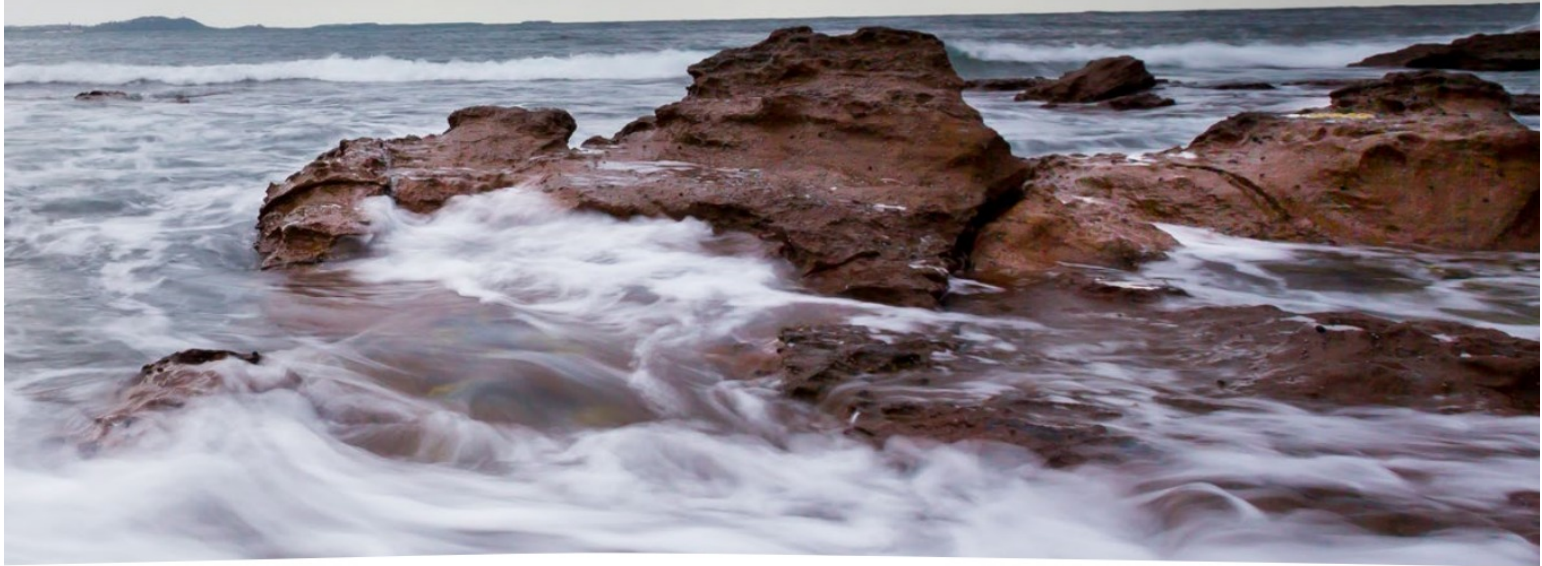
As the millennia passed and sea levels rose, more evidence of coastal tribes has been found. The Shellharbour region in particular was **an abundant source of fish and shellfish, along with reptiles and land animals. The lush forests also yielded fruits, berries, seeds, nuts, honeys and nectars** – with all food traded along tracks

that often mirror today's roads, including Macquarie Pass up the escarpment to the west.

When Europeans came ashore in 1797 (Bass Point is named after the first of them), it wasn't the fruits or seeds that interested them – it was the trees themselves. **Vast swathes of red cedar – a towering giant prized for its timber – blanketed the land from the ocean to the hills.** By the mid 19th century, with the cedar cutting in full swing (literally!), it was joined by basalt (and later coal) mining. Raw materials shipped out to Sydney from the fast-growing port at Peterborough, which was later renamed Shellharbour Village.

◀ PREVIOUSLY, ON SHELLHARBOUR

- 🕒 The name **Shellharbour** itself comes from the masses of shells on the local beaches in the early days of European settlement. These were collected and burnt to manufacture shell-lime mortar that was used for building.
- 🕒 Right up until the 1930s, the shores of **Lake Illawarra** had giant sand dunes up to 70-feet high. The sand was removed to make way for housing – some was even sent to Hawaii!
- 🕒 The Albion Park suburb of **Tullimbar** is named in honour of a powerful Aboriginal leader in the Macquarie Pass region, who died in 1870.
- 🕒 Learn all about the heritage and life in the early settlement by downloading the free **Tread Shellharbour** app walking tour for your phone.



As the 20th century approached, **dairy farming** became prominent on the cleared lands. Later, many of these original farms were converted to estates designed to attract Sydney holidaymakers, in particular around the shores of Lake Illawarra. **By the 1930s, tourism was big business in the area** – with Shellharbour’s newly opened Ocean Beach Hotel purpose-built for the tourist market and boats ferrying guests to houses across the lake. In fact, it wasn’t until 1938 that the entrance to the lake at Warilla was finally bridged.

Shellharbour Airport started its life during World War II, as an airstrip to train pilots in defending nearby Port Kembla. Also of note, in 1969, the unique rainforests of **Macquarie Pass** were declared a National Park – helping to preserve the natural beauty we still enjoy today.



WHEELS OF MISFORTUNE

Windang Island is a great place to explore – easily accessible from the shore at low tide and filled with telltale signs of its past.

The rusted wheels that can be seen on the island are more than a century old. They were linked to an unsuccessful plan to mine the island for coal. Throughout the 1890s, plans were drawn up to dredge and establish a harbour inside Lake Illawarra, and a new breakwall was actually built, only to be washed away by heavy seas within a few years. What remains today are the rails and wheels from the trolleys that were used to shift the quarried rock for the wall.

You might say that the wheels certainly came off that idea!

⚓ MAKING THE MARINA

- ✓ More than **1.3 million cubic metres** (or 4 million bathtubs) of material was excavated to create the harbour basin – with almost all material reused onsite.
- ✓ Shellharbour Marina's basin area is **30% larger** than Sydney's Darling Harbour.
- ✓ A large **sand bank** held back the ocean during construction, with the public invited to walk around on the harbour floor prior to letting the water in!
- ✓ The maximum water depth is **5 metres**.
- ✓ The breakwall and groyne were made from **400,000 tonnes** of rock. The largest single rock weighed 62 tonnes and was the size of a Hummer SUV!
- ✓ Around the outside there are **220 concrete edge walls**, weighing on average 17 tonnes each.




Watching the sun rise and shimmer in the calm waters of Australia's newest marina is a real treat. In fact, to see the rapid growth of Shell Cove in the past 5-10 years, **from swamp to seaside sophistication**, is truly remarkable.

Undeniably, this is the region's new hub – surrounded by a mix of family-friendly housing, new apartments, walkways and reserves. The town centre features **shopping, services and dining in multiple venues**

including the iconic Waterfront Tavern. It also plays host to regular markets and community events every month.

But wait there's 'moor'. The brand-new Marina, with its outlet to the ocean, has redrawn the coastline and provides **moorings for 300 boats**. Hugging its perimeter is a 3km boardwalk – a wonderful walking or jogging route. You can also take a whale watching cruise directly from the jetty.

Are you ready to make a splash?

SWIMMING

Down here on the South Coast, you'll never feel crowded if you decide to take a refreshing dip. From golden sands and crashing waves of **The Farm at Killalea and Warilla beaches** to the gentler waters of **Shell Cove, Little Lake and Lake Illawarra**, there's something to suit everyone (including outdoor pools – see pg 27). You'll even find the original 'rain shower' experience among the waterfalls and pools of **Macquarie National Park** – bring a waterproof camera to snap the magic!

DIVING & SNORKELLING

If you prefer not to water down your water-based fun, then put those flippers and that mask on and head to **Bass Point** – an historic coastal gem that's ideal for exploring the world 'down under'. Whether it's snorkelling amongst the diverse marine life at **Bushranger's Bay** (a declared Aquatic Reserve) or scuba diving the reefs and shipwrecks, our coast's hidden wonders will not disappoint!

FISHING

Dropping a line is almost as easy as dropping a pin on the map – such is the ridiculous regularity of fishing spots in our bountiful region. Whether you're on shore or in a tinnie, **Lake Illawarra** is a great place to start. The boat ramps at **Shellharbour, Shell Cove, Bass Point, Windang and Oak Flats** cater for any BYO boating you have planned. Rather have it all taken care of? Then jump aboard with a local fishing charter – they know where to find the fish.



SURFING

It's no coincidence that some of the top surfers in Australia cut their teeth on South Coast waves. **The Farm** in Killalea Regional Park is a surfing mecca – a frothing amphitheatre of amped up boardriding that rarely sees a bad day. Nearby you'll also find classic waves at **Mystics Beach**, while other quality spots work their way up the coast from **Bass Point and Shellharbour South through to Warilla beaches** and the long leftie off **Windang Island**.

Killalea is also the place to go for lessons, with The Pines Academy loading you up with everything you need to get up and riding your first waves in style. Yewww!



PADDLING

Remember those calmer waters we were telling you about earlier? Well, they also happen to be ideal for kayaking or stand-up paddleboarding. In particular, **Minnamurra River** is a fan favourite, while **Lake Illawarra** is the waterway that just keeps on giving, boasting literally miles of coastline to explore. Of course, if you're feeling more adventurous, you can take to the waves too, or try out the newly minted harbour at **Shell Cove**, complete with a kayak launch ramp – it certainly has your post-paddling aperitif taken care of!

SLIDES & SPLASHES

You know what? Sometimes you just want the water to bend itself into the shape of a spiral slide, lazy river or wave pool. And that's okay, because just a 15-minute drive from Shellharbour Village, you'll find **Jamberoo Action Park** – NSW's most beloved water wonderland (open September to April). With world-class giant slides and rides, picnic areas, food outlets and plenty of action and fun for the whole family, it's the cherry on top of this region's water-themed delights.



BOATING

A new world-class lifestyle boating destination awaits you at **Shellharbour Marina** – offering a safe harbour just 50 nautical miles from Sydney and 30 nautical miles from Jervis Bay.

The first stage includes 145 berths, along with a marine services building, fuel pontoon and pump out facility – with an additional 125 berths and dry boat storage to come in stage two.

Back to NATURE



Ready to reconnect with nature?
Here are our picks of where to get
up close and personal...



KILLALEA REGIONAL PARK

With its surf breaks already beloved by boardriders (it became a National Surfing Reserve in 2009), Killalea – named after 19th century Irish immigrant Edward Killalea – is **an oasis of lush native coastal land**.

The entrance to the park is its highest point, with lookouts showcasing the panoramic views and tracks radiating out from the carparks, BBQs and cafe atop the headland. Walk the length of south-facing Killalea Beach (also known as 'The Farm') or roll on to the end of the road for picnics, bushwalking and camping near Mystics Beach and Minnamurra River. A magical spot and a must-visit any time of day, any season.

BASS POINT

Killalea's neighbour to the east, Bass Point is a prominent landmark – a rocky outcrop jutting out into the sea and for thousands of years, historically an important camping and meeting spot.

Today the site is accessed through the new Shell Cove development and includes a rich and diverse mix of coastal rainforest housing rare and endangered species. A hidden gem on the southern side within the reserve is **Bushrangers Bay, a protected Aquatic Reserve that is hugely popular with snorkelers and divers**. You can also experience the Bass Point Indigenous Cultural Walk plus other notable sites including those of shipwrecks over the years.

BLACKBUTT FOREST RESERVE

Surrounded on all sides by urban areas, the family-friendly 250-acre Blackbutt Forest Reserve provides a unique window to the past – home to the region’s last remaining significant coastal plains forest.

These days it’s a welcome mix of BBQ/picnic areas, bushwalking and cycle tracks, open space and playgrounds (as well as magical forest light events throughout the year). But you only have to step in amongst the trees to appreciate **the diverse vegetation and wildlife** here, providing a glimpse of how everything must have looked covered in this botanic blanket some two hundred years ago.

MACQUARIE PASS NATIONAL PARK

First Nations People followed trading tracks up to the escarpment for thousands of years before the first road made its way up Macquarie Pass in 1898. Today this is where nature lovers are truly in their element, with hiking trails that criss-cross these lush slopes and showcase the **rare and majestic rainforests, tumbling waterfalls and secret swimming holes** that Instagram has made famous.

With an abundance of native animals and birdlife to see and hear – all against a backdrop of dramatic cliff faces, gullies and ancient forest – you’ll truly feel connected with Mother Nature in this special corner of the world. (For recommended walks, see page 14.)

EXPLORE

on Foot or Bike



With our mix of multiple waterfront pathways, scenic trails and rolling foothills, **the Shellharbour region has many opportunities to explore both on foot or on two wheels...**

Walking and cycling can take you places that cars often cannot reach – allowing you to slow down and take in the sights and the sounds of our beautiful natural settings. From the history-rich coast to lush rainforests of the escarpment, there's a trail or path to suit all levels.

KILLALEA & BASS POINT

The panoramic views on offer at Killalea Regional Park are stunning. From the kiosk and car park, trails lead down to the beach (**The Farm**) and you can continue around **Killalea Lagoon** – a thriving habitat for around 60 bird and frog species. A sealed road traverses the entire length of the park, ending at unspoilt **Mystics Beach**. Meanwhile, adjacent, the **Bass Point Indigenous Cultural Walk** showcases one of the two most important archaeological sites on the entire NSW coast – with beautiful views and unique historical features.

SHELLHARBOUR COAST

There are approximately 3km of paths, promenades and boardwalks at the new **Shellharbour Marina** (from breakwater to groynes), with ample amenities along the way. A popular sealed biking/walking trail also runs from **Shellharbour Village to Reddall Reserve** (approx 5km)

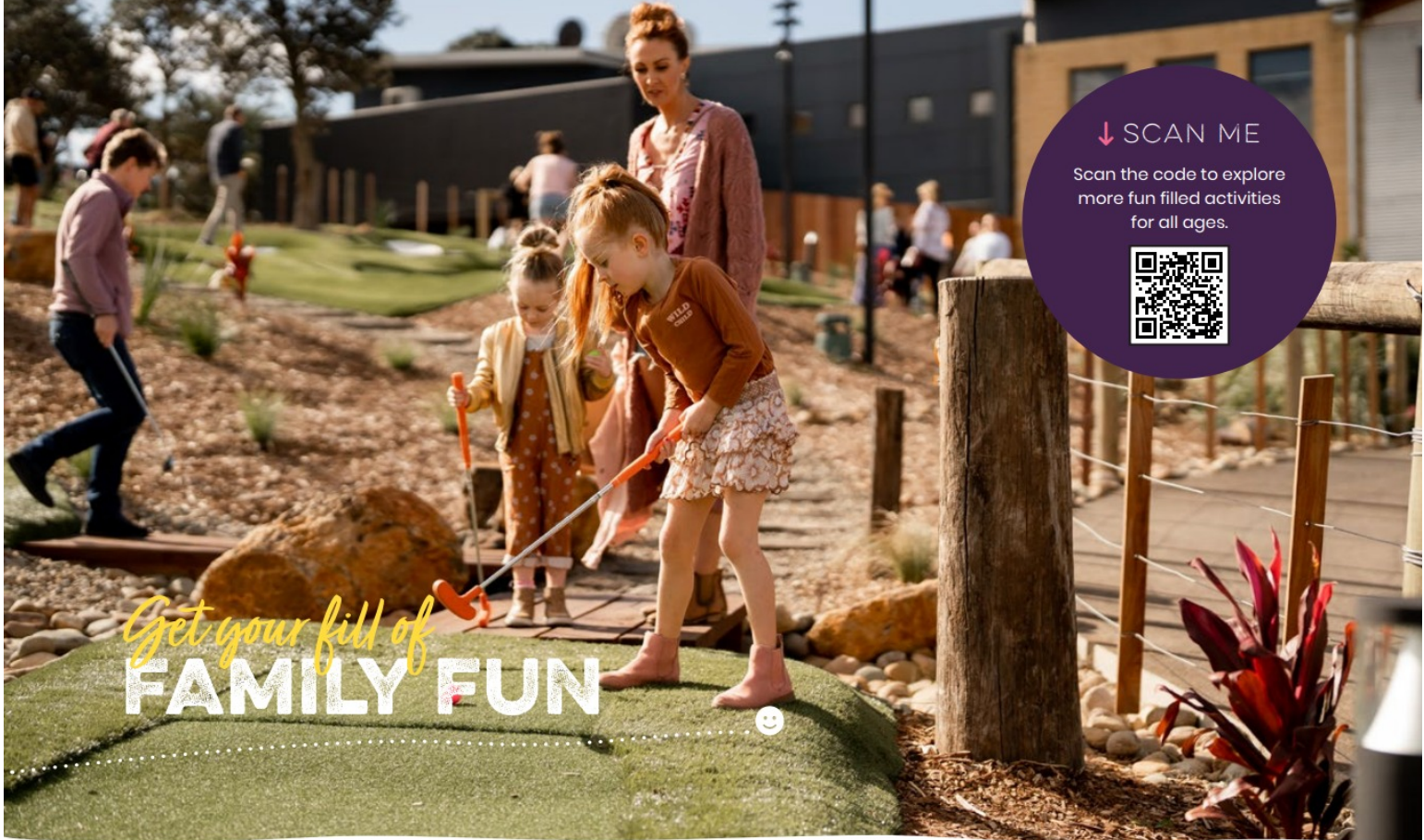
via Little Lake, with history and birdlife to explore on foot along the way at the **Windang and Picnic Islands** – best accessed in low tide. (See page 7 for more details.)

LAKE ILLAWARRA & BLACKBUTT

The shared use paths around **Lake Illawarra**, starting from Reddall Reserve, are a 'must do' for cyclists or keen walkers/joggers – approx 7km one-way, with BBQ facilities, playgrounds and an Art Trail (see page 17 for more information). There are also walking and cycle tracks aplenty in **Blackbutt Reserve** – a suburban oasis of natural bushland reserve and last remaining remnant of significant coastal plains forest in the region.


MACQUARIE PASS NATIONAL PARK

The escarpment is a wonderland of walking tracks to explore. At the base, the 2km return **Cascades Walk** is easy and rewarding, taking you through rainforest and eucalypt forest home to lyrebirds, platypus, goannas and abundant birdlife to reach its waterfall. Meanwhile, further up the Pass, the 6km return **Rainbow Falls** track follows a disused logging trail through native figs, lillypillys, ferns and lianas to reward you with the stunning namesake falls. Definitely bring your camera!

Planes, trains and automobiles. No, we're not simply listing the ways that you can travel here – rather some excellent attractions to enjoy while you're with us. Ladies and gentlemen (and kids)... start your engines!

HARS AVIATION MUSEUM

Open every day, the **Historic Aircraft Restoration Society (HARS) Aviation Museum** is a wonderland of wings and a must-visit destination to anyone who enjoys getting up close to some of history's amazing flying machines. Located, naturally, at Shellharbour Airport, this volunteer-run attraction is quite literally a labour of love, with old aircraft lovingly restored and maintained for you to enjoy.

The current display collection includes many flying and static aircraft such as the Southern Cross II (a replica Fokker trimotor), three C-47/DC-3 aircraft, Lockheed Super Constellation "Connie", a DC-4 and other historic craft

such as Caribou, CA-27 Sabre, Tiger Moth and many more. But the jumbo-sized elephant in the room is the **Qantas 747-438 "City of Canberra"** – touching down here in Shellharbour to great fanfare upon its retirement in 2015.

This is not your usual museum – with a tour guide taking you through working hangars and allowing you to get up close to the aircraft. **Restoration is always taking place**, which means there's always something new to see. John Travolta has even visited in person and has donated his Boeing 707 to HARS for restoration, such is the global reputation of the workmanship here.

With **Café Connie on site** and a surprising array of machines to marvel at, you'll definitely want to clear at least a few hours in your day for this unique experience!



ILLAWARRA LIGHT RAIL MUSEUM

Located just a short hop from the airport, you'll find this charming museum – recently **celebrating 50 years in the region**. Of course, some of the historical items on show are much older, including a 1915 signal box from the South Coast line.

If you can time your visit with the second Sunday or fourth Saturday of each month, you'll be rewarded with a "full steam ahead" experience. This includes the steam train being operational, as well as a tram and miniature rides. For fun family entertainment and a touch of history, all in a natural setting, you're on the right track with this spot!

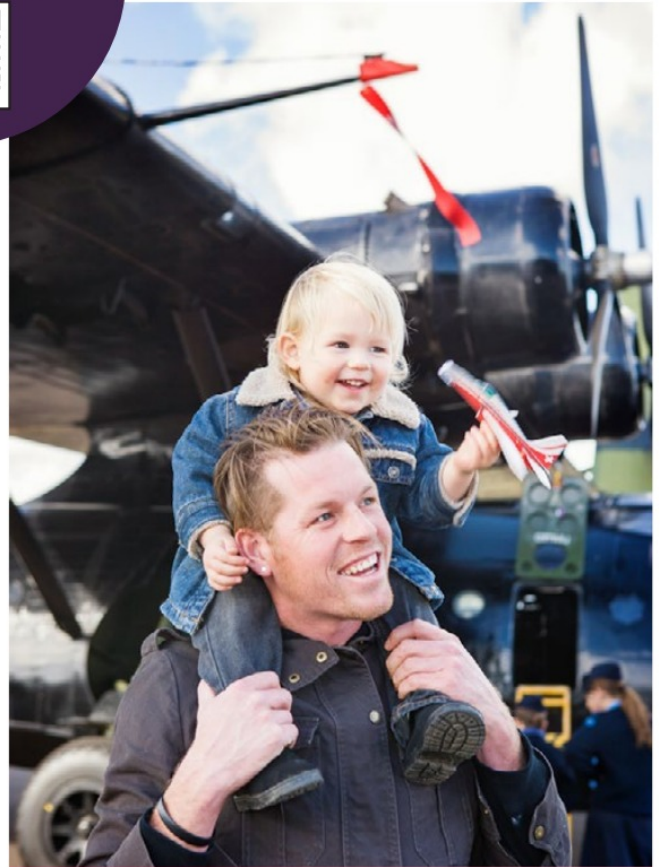

C1 SPEED / MOTORLIFE MUSEUM

While you're near the airport, why not get behind the wheel and enjoy fun go-kart racing at **C1 Speed Indoor Karting**. This unique multi-purpose venue is noted for its spectacular circuit design – with more than 400m of straights, chicanes and curves, and a fleet of 30 current generation electric karts (much safer and better-performing than petrol karts). If older automobiles are more your 'speed', head just 15 minutes north to **The Australian Motorlife Museum** in Kembla Grange to experience a huge collection including vehicles from the early 1900s through to the 1960s. Motorcycles, trucks, a 1924 Fire engine complete with brass helmets, an FJ Holden with a Caravan, early petrol pumps and so much more – a fascinating place to visit for all ages.

TOURIST DRIVE 8

→ **Distance:** 120km return

Doing a lap of the "neighbourhood" along Tourist Drive 8 (Illawarra Highway) will take you west of here, through Albion Park and the ruggedly beautiful **Macquarie Pass National Park**. Stop to view the Cascades Waterfall before heading up to Robertson in the Southern Highlands.

Robertson is known for its famous pie shop and antiques. It's also where the film *Babe* was made. A short drive from here gets you to the spectacular Fitzroy Falls, a brilliant 230 metre high natural fountain of white water.

A little further down the road, you'll find yourself in the picture-postcard village of **Kangaroo Valley**, surrounded by ruggedly beautiful mountains and bushland. It's got a great pub with views of the valley and mountains. Just out of the village is the historic Hampden Bridge with its imposing stone turrets, the oldest (and obviously built to last) suspension bridge in NSW. Driving across it gives you a sense of the past, with fantastic views of the river below.

Heading south out of the valley, you will emerge at Bomaderry, where you can cross the river into Nowra or head north through cute-as-a-button **Berry** and onto **Kiama** (get a spray from the famous blowhole). You're then just a short drive back to Shellharbour, to enjoy a great meal and prepare for your next adventure.

GRAND PACIFIC DRIVE

→ **Distance:** 140km

Grand Pacific Drive is a 140 kilometre scenic coastal drive taking you through lush rainforests starting in the **Royal National Park**, over the Sea Cliff Bridge and through the coastal townships of **Wollongong, Shellharbour, Kiama and the Shoalhaven region**, on the stunning South Coast of New South Wales.

There are endless experiences to be enjoyed along your way, from adrenaline-pumping adventure activities to delicious food and wine, family discoveries, natural wonders and too many beaches to count!

You can choose to make your way back to Sydney via the charming Southern Highlands or continue heading south to the Victorian border through the picturesque regions of Eurobodalla and Sapphire Coast.
